Note to Braille edition

This note to braille edition applies to all the braille files in this collection.

These songs are written *line-by-line*: a line of words, with the corresponding music written underneath, indented three cells. Bar numbers are shown at the beginning of Each line of music, enclosed in music brackets $\cdot = 7$. A dot three following the bar number, for example $\cdot = 7 \# d' 7$ indicates that the bar is a continuation from the previous line.

All intervals read downwards.

Lyrics are written in uncontracted Unified English Braille.

The sign $\cdot = 9$ surrounding lyrics indicates they should be repeated the given number of times. Thus $\cdot = \# e 9 s o 9$ indicates the word “so” should be sung a total of six times.

Longer expressions in the music are enclosed in word signs

$\cdot = >$ and spaced from the surrounding music.

Stem signs are used to show unpitched notes in metronome markings.

The sign $\cdot = @ a$ is used to represent glissando lines between notes.
