**HORSE**

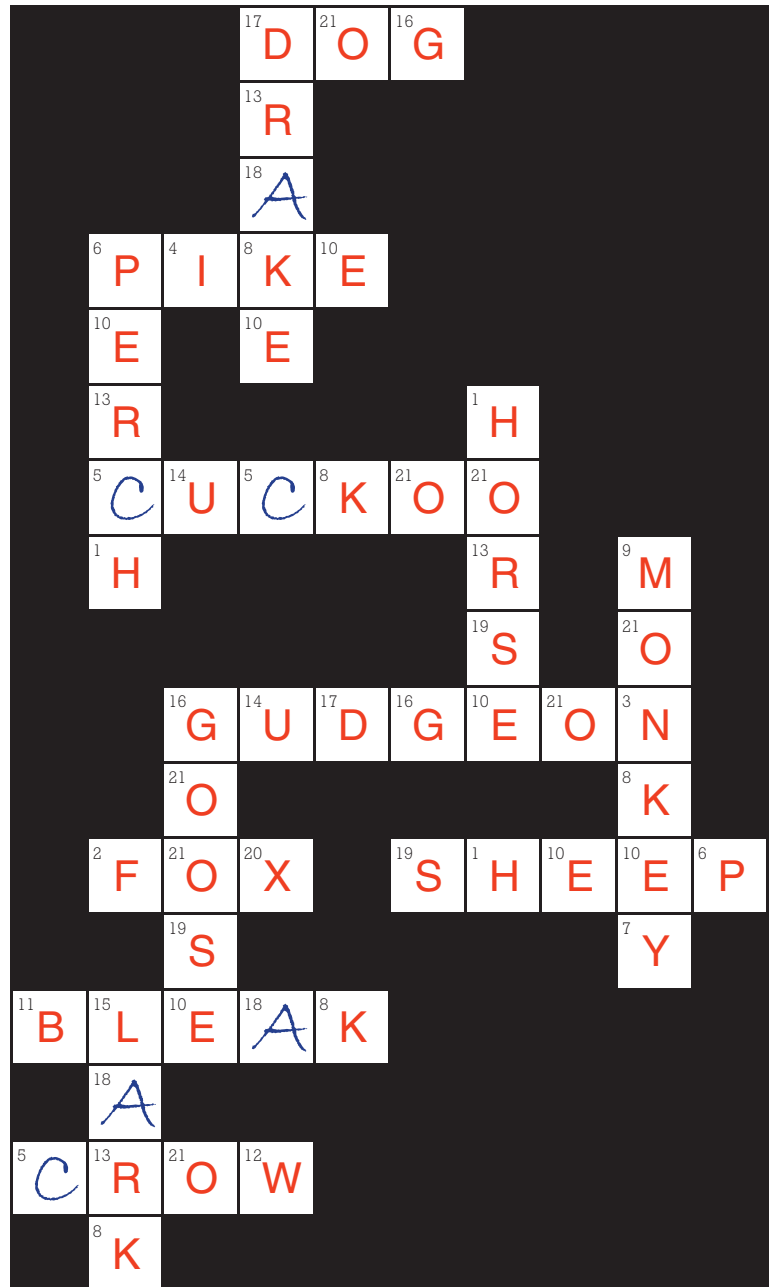
